INVITATION TO PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON PROPOSED CHARGES, FEES AND LEVIES

The Cabinet Secretary for Interior and National Administration has published intended **charges**, **fees** and **levies** for various services provided by the State Department for **Immigration and Citizen Services** vide Gazette Notice Vol. CXXV—No. 241 dated 14th November, 2023.

The intended revised charges, fees and levies that will take effect on **January 1, 2024** are informed by the increase in the cost of the respective services over the years and the need to make the rendering of the services self–sustaining.

In view of the above, the State Department for Immigration and Citizen Services invites views and proposals from members of the public and other stakeholders on the intended revision for consideration.
